



Our Playground Rules

To enable us to enjoy our playtimes and lunchtimes we should remember these rules:

- We have good manners and respect the people and property around us.
- We play outside and do not go inside unless we have permission.
- If we have a problem at break times we speak to the adult on duty.
- We only come in to the cloakroom to use the toilet.
- We use the front playground for football, huff and puff, chasing and skipping games and the back playground for quieter games and the equipment.
- We always walk along the pathway between the front and back playgrounds.
- We stop playing when the bell goes and quietly line up or walk into school.
- We go into the dining hall sensibly and eat our lunch quietly.



Important Routines

- ❖ When we arrive at school, after 8.40 a.m., we hang up our bags, put our lunchboxes into the crates/trolleys, put folders and files into classrooms and go straight outside until the bell goes. If it is wet, we stay in our classrooms.

**Parents are encouraged to leave children at the gate and if they need to see a teacher or secretary to come in the back way please.*
- ❖ When it is time to come in for lunch we will walk to the back playground and line up before going into the cloakrooms to quietly wash our hands. We remember our manners when we eat our lunch. If we have to eat in the classroom we make sure that we leave our desk area clean before leaving.
- ❖ We always keep to the left when walking quietly around the school.
- ❖ During wet playtimes we find something quiet to do and clear up after ourselves.
- ❖ When we are in the cloakroom we gather all our things up quickly and quietly before we go home.

Consequences

Forms of praise may include:

- ✓ Praising acceptable behaviour
- ✓ Praising an attempt at acceptable behaviour
- ✓ Praise from peers
- ✓ Sending to another member of staff for praise
- ✓ Awarding beach points
- ✓ Giving special responsibilities
- ✓ Choosing their own activity/Golden Time
- ✓ Verbal/written praise to parents/carers
- ✓ Giving non-verbal messages of approval - smiling, thumbs up, high-5
- ✓ Giving material rewards - small prizes, tokens
- ✓ Giving smiley faces/stickers/star charts/certificates
- ✓ Recording in lunchtime behaviour books

Sanctions will include:

- Verbal reminder/warning (level 1)
- Temporary isolation from incident (level 2):
 - In the classroom, moving to a different table
 - During lunchtime, sitting on their own to eat lunch
 - During playtime, standing by the wall and missing play
- If no improvement following two verbal reminders then referral to the Headteacher or Assistant Headteacher (level 3)
- Loss of privileges where appropriate (level 4)
- A form of apology is expected
- Certain behaviour has zero tolerance resulting in referral straight to the Headteacher . e.g. swearing, lack of respect, aggressive behaviour, bullying, rude gestures, endangering self or others
- Unacceptable behaviour is recorded in behaviour logs and/or lunchtime behaviour books
