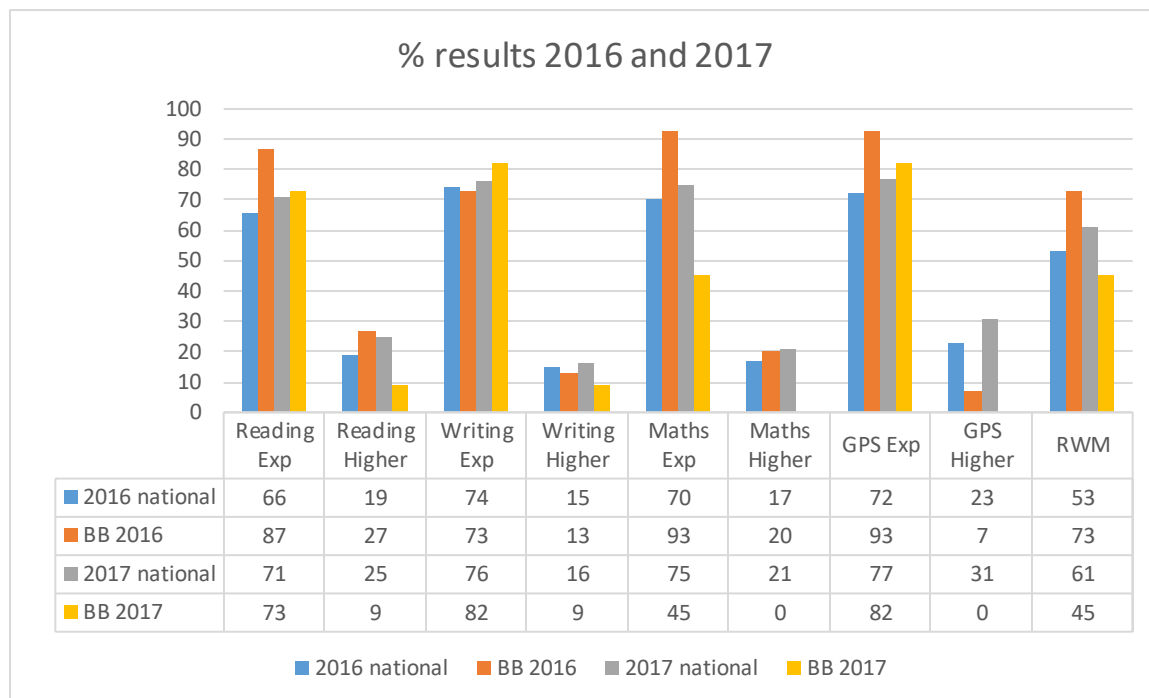


Key Stage 2 Results for Burton Bradstock School (2016 & 2017)

Burton Bradstock Primary School are pleased with their results in Reading, Writing and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling but were disappointed in their Maths results. There were 11 students in the year group so each represents 9%. The prior attainment of the year group was well below the national average and overall, except in Maths, pupils made expected progress in line with their previous attainment at KS1.

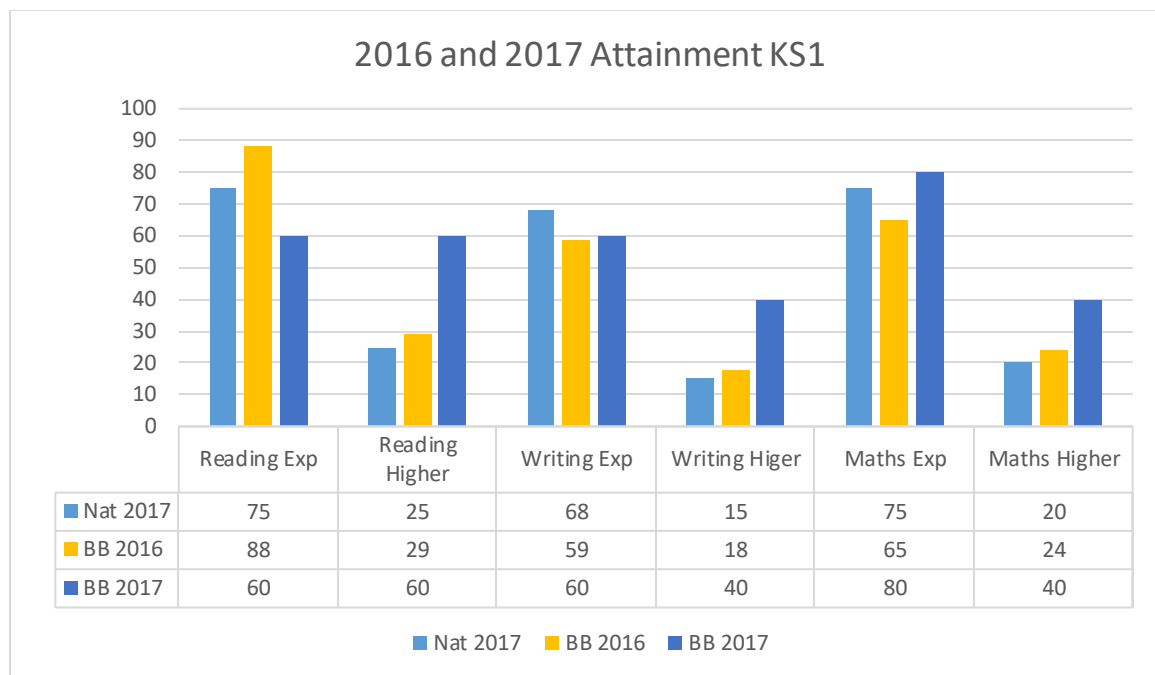


Progress KS2

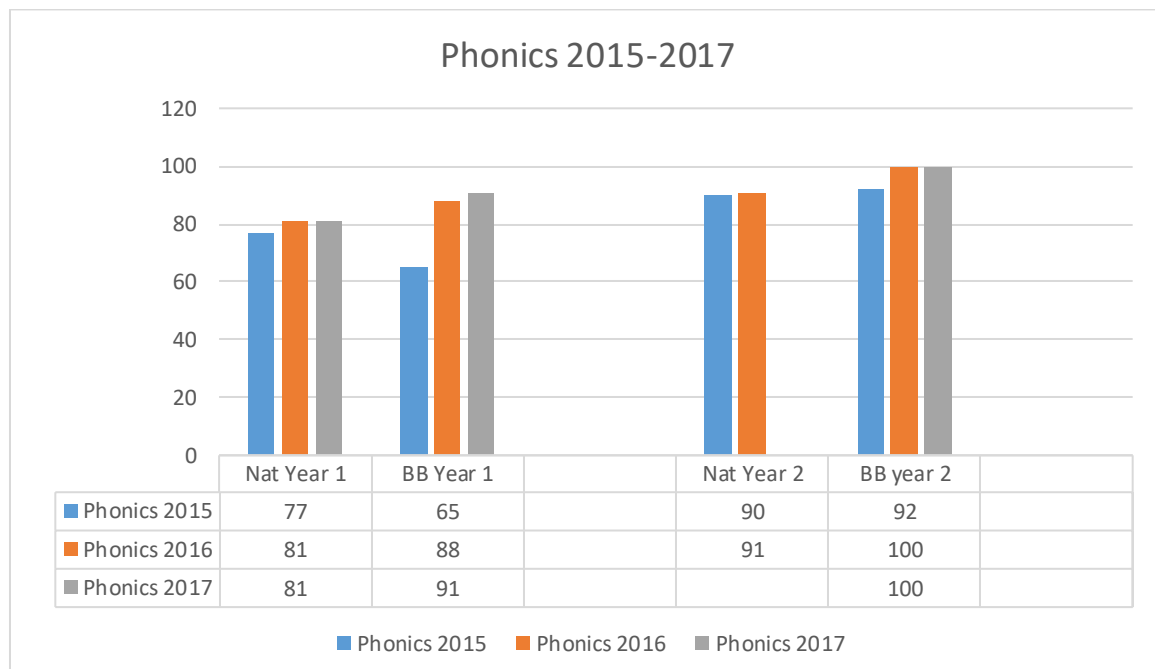

There has been a significant improvement in progress in Writing and progress in Reading remains above the national average. The year group did not perform as well as expected in the Mathematics test.

There were only 5 pupils in year 2 so each is worth 20% and the statistics should, therefore, be treated with care. However, these were pleasing results overall and the improvement in Mathematics is particularly good.



Phonics results have risen steadily in the school and are now a real success story and above the national average.
