New Term Information for Parents – Kingfisher Class


Dear Parents/Carers

Please familiarise yourself with the following information regarding the systems in place in Kingfisher Class.

Reading

Mrs Scriven and I will read with your child every week. Some more regularly than others. Children will have a reading record, which needs to be signed 3 times a week by grown-ups. Each read can be anything from 5-15 minutes. They can read their school book or a text of your choice (newspaper, non-fiction book). Teachers will write in your child's reading record every time they read with them in school. This will help create a close link between school and home. There is a plethora of books in their newly developed reading corner for them to explore. Kingfisher class with be taken to the village library once a week. This is to help promote their love of reading and give them some excitement when selecting new and fascinating books.



Homework

Homework tasks will be set each Friday on See Saw, starting Friday 8th September. Homework will need to be completed and submitted on See Saw by the following Thursday. Log in details will be fixed inside your child's reading record for reference at a later date.

Spellings

Spelling lists will be set on Spelling Frame each Friday, starting Friday 8th September. A fun spelling quiz will take place each Friday morning, starting 22nd September. Log in details will be fixed inside your child's reading record for reference at a later date

Times Table Rockstars

Times tables games will be set each week for your child to practice, starting Friday 8th September. Please encourage children to practice frequently to build their fluency in recalling multiplication facts. Your child's login details can be found at the front of their reading record.

PE

PE days for Kingfisher class will be **Wednesday** and **Friday**. Please send your child into school already wearing their PE kit, starting Friday 8th September. They will spend the day in their kits instead of changing in class.
