MATHEMATICS

Rec - Number: Addition and Subtraction. Measurement: Shape and Time

Year 5/6 - Recounts/Diary writing. Auto-biography/biography. Significant Author: Louis Sacher.

UNDERSTANDING THE WORLD

Science -

Rec – materials. Animal homes.
KS1 - Everyday materials: identify, describe, compare and group.
Year 3/4 – Electricity.
Year 5/6 - Electricity and Materials.

Geography -

Rec – Villages and Towns.
KS1 - Human features and Vocabulary - city, town, village, farm etc. Use aerial photographs and plans; devise maps and symbols in a key.
Year 3/4 - Land use/changes. Settlement, economic activity.
Year 5/6 - Energy. Distribution of natural resources. Renewable energy.

History -

Rec – Houses and homes in Burton Bradstock.
KS1 - Events beyond living memory: the Plague/Great Fire of London. Changes within living memory: houses and homes.
Year 3/4 - How houses have changed through the ages.
Year 5/6 - A local historical study.

RE -

Rec – Celebrations in different religions. Why do Christians put a cross in an Easter garden?
KS1 – Was it always easy for Jesus to show friendship? Why does Easter matter to Christians?
Year 3/4 - What do Christians learn from the Creation story? Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?
Year 5/6 - Are Sikh stories important today? What do Christians believe Jesus did to save human beings?

Computing - Internet Safety.

Rec – Coding. Beebots.
KS1 - Coding. Programming beebots. Word (saving).
Year 3/4 - Word. Coding.
Year 5/6 - Excel. Coding.

Languages - French vocabulary and reading, writing and speaking simple phrases.
